In the midst of all of this political action and movement, it is important to remember that this is very much a family issue and a personal issue for many people. Unfortunately, it has not been much of a family or personal issue for Jim Sensenbrenner, who has assets of around \$10 million.

Around one million of his dollars are invested in the Kimberly-Clark brand of products, which La Raza Justice Movement, hopefully with your help, will be boycotting. Kimberly-Clark owns many different brands, including: Kleenex, Scott, Huggies, Cottonelle, Viva, Pull-Ups, Kotex and Depend.

We are seeking individuals and organizations to help support the boycott by becoming signature sponsors. We ask that signature sponsors commit to gathering fifty to one hundred signatures a piece. Our current plan is to continue organizing the boycott at least through January, as we believe that the politicians will not resolve anything on the immigration debate this year. We are also seeking businesses to support the boycott by pledging not to stock their businesses with Kimberly-Clark products.

Already many organizations in Houston are working on different aspects of the boycott, including targeted campaigns aimed at encouraging retailers to honor the boycott. In Houston, CRECEN/America Para Todos, JIFM (Jovenes Inmigrantes por un Futuro Mejor), La Nueva Raza Newspaper, La Raza Justice Movement, Liberation Baptist Church, M.E.X.A. (Movimiento Estudiantil Xicana/o de Aztlan) and Nuestra Palabra have joined the national call to boycott Kimberly Clark products.

"It's a free country. People are free to buy what they want to buy or not buy what they don't want to buy," said Sensenbrenner in an interview. Hopefully we can convince people that they shouldn't buy his products, especially since the bill is still up for negotiation.

On December 6, 2005, House Judiciary Committee Chair Rep. Jim Sensenbrenner (R-W I) introduced the "Border Protection, Antiterrorism, and Illegal Immigration Control Act of 2005" (H.R. 4437). H.R. 4437 has many provisions, including the creation of a wall at the border, making felons out of undocumented workers and criminalizing anyone, including social workers and church officials that help undocumented immigrants.

Sensenbrenner is a major stockholder of Kimberly-Clark which owns Kleenex, Viva, Cottonelle, Kotex, Depends, Scott, Huggies, and Pull-Ups. Due to Sensenbrenner's continuous efforts to criminalize and attack immigrant communities and families, many local organizations have decided to boycott his products. Additionally, local businesses such as Taqueria Alma Latina, New Day Lending, and the Law Offices of Hector A. Chavana have also signed on as supporters. Most recently, supporters from other cities like Dallas have signed on as sponsors as well.

As a local community organization, we would like to request that your business joins us in our efforts to "vote with our dollars."
